It's awkward and not comfortable at all!



Let's put your story together!

- 1. It is yours!
- 2. How did you start? (the trigger, the "aha" moment)
- 3. What did you do? (Your work)
- 4. What keeping you going? (The impact, the numbers)
- 5. You are the expert in your life, your field/area = impress that
- 6. Example: I use a timeline (It has to be you)







your online persona

- the FACE of your work online
- always use the **SAME SPELLING** for your name
 - o use LinkedIn's Audio Feature for pronunciation
- ENGAGE in conversations, state your opinion
 - It could be tiring
- don't be modest
 - o FLEX
- CREATE blogs, articles, videos...etc.
 - easier to know more

You on the Stage

- Study the whole situation:
 - O Why me?
 - Who are they?
 - Where am I going to be speaking?
 - What's at stake? (politics, economics, history, geography)
- Distance and position
- Being vocal = it's a choice
- Sensitivity
- Learn the language
- Improvise, but come prepared (practice)
- Don't lose yourself







common challenges

- It's not comfortable = It's a matter of experience
- It could be exhausting = You will find your balance
- Mistakes happen = We learn the hard way
- It's not enough = It's way better than you think
- Are we bragging?
